This Sunday, June 23, we welcome a visiting priest to do our annual "Mission Appeal." And the second collections at the Masses allow us to contribute to the missionary work of the Universal Church each year.

This Sunday is also the beautiful feast of *Corpus Christi*, the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. It is a reminder of the great gift we find in the Holy Eucharist, that we have the privilege of receiving so often as our "Food for the Journey."
